DISCUSSION Is it possible to avoid multiple QA procedures in international joint degree programmes?

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QUALITY ASSURANCE OF HEI'S IN FINLAND

Audit of the university's QA systems every six years obligatory

Accreditation of individual degree programmes – not obligatory

It's possible to have audit by any QA agency listed in The European Quality Assurance Register for Higher Education (EQAR)

Enhancement-led evaluation is the main principle in audits by The Finnish Education Evaluation Centre (FINEEC) The University of Helsinki (UH) passed the latest audit in 2022

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TWO PROCEDURES FOR QA OF DEGREÊ PROGRAMMES AT UH

ANNUAL FOLLOW-UP SINCE 2019

Degree programmes assess their activities "How are we doing?"

- follow-up with connection to operations management and planning

REVIEW AS OF 2023

About once every three years: "Time to reflect – is there a need to reform the university structures and the programme portfolio of UH " -evaluation with recommendations for development

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BUILDING MUTUAL TRUST IN INTERNATIONAL HEI NETWORKS

Knowledge of each partner's practices in QA of education

Experiences of successful cooperation in joint educational programs and exchanges

Trust in each other's high quality in education

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TWO DIFFERENT WORLDS OF QA

ENHANCEMENT-LED

- Aiming for development
- Finding good practices and development areas
- Motivating the participants
- Usefulness for the participants
- Practices are developed together with the participants

ACCREDITATION-BASED

- For quality control
- Participation is compulsory
- QA practices are formal repeated on a regular basis Accreditation provides evidence of adequate quality

COOPERATION IS BASED ON TRUST BETWEEN THE JOINT DEGREE PROGRAMME PARTNERS

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CHALLENGES

- For international joint degree programme, the QA method chosen is the most common practice = accreditation
- The criteria of the most strictly regulated partners have the strongest impact
- Multiple QA processes and reporting are an almost inevitable result of the point above
- Impossible to avoid multiplication of student surveys and monitoring
