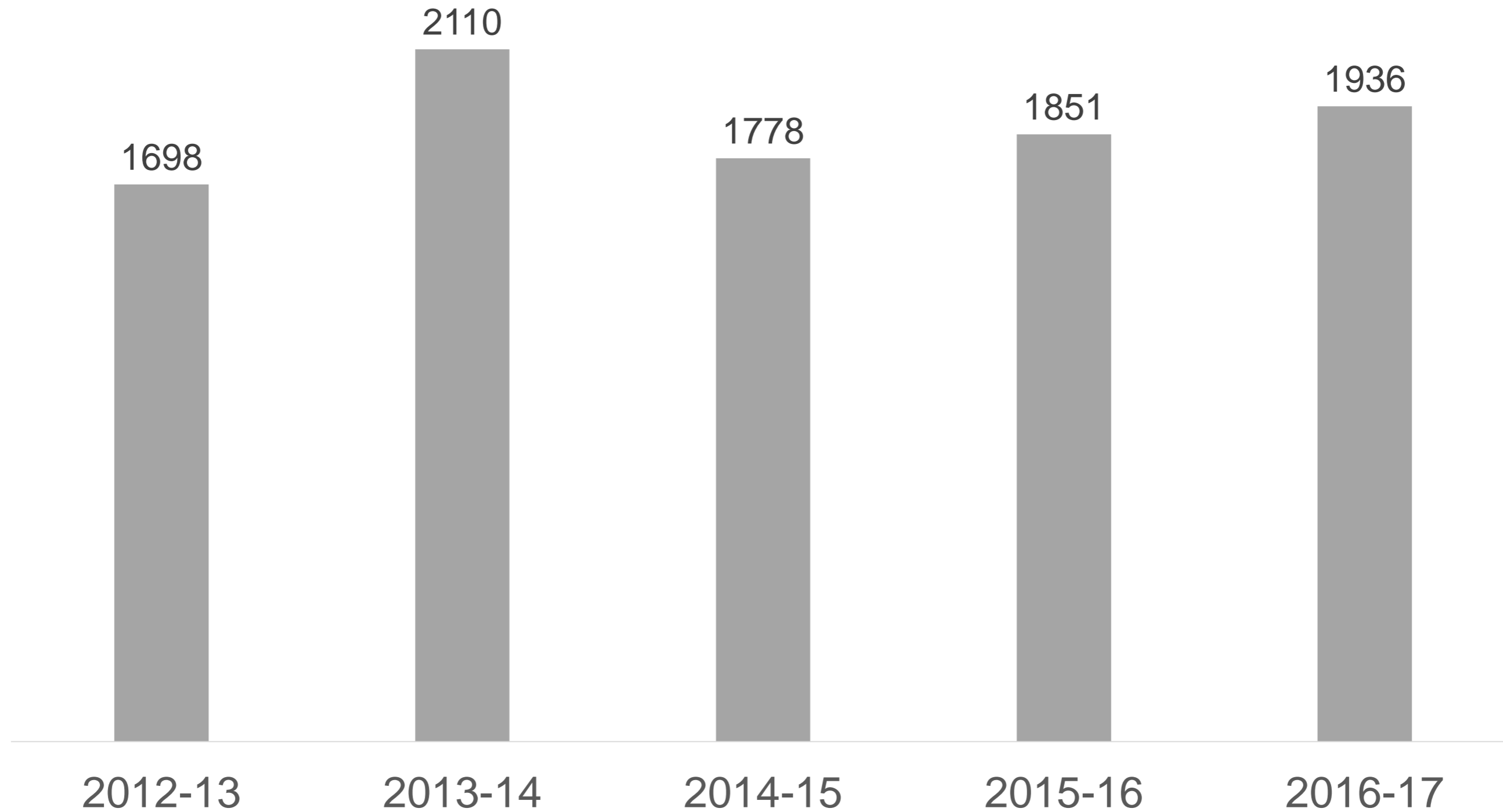

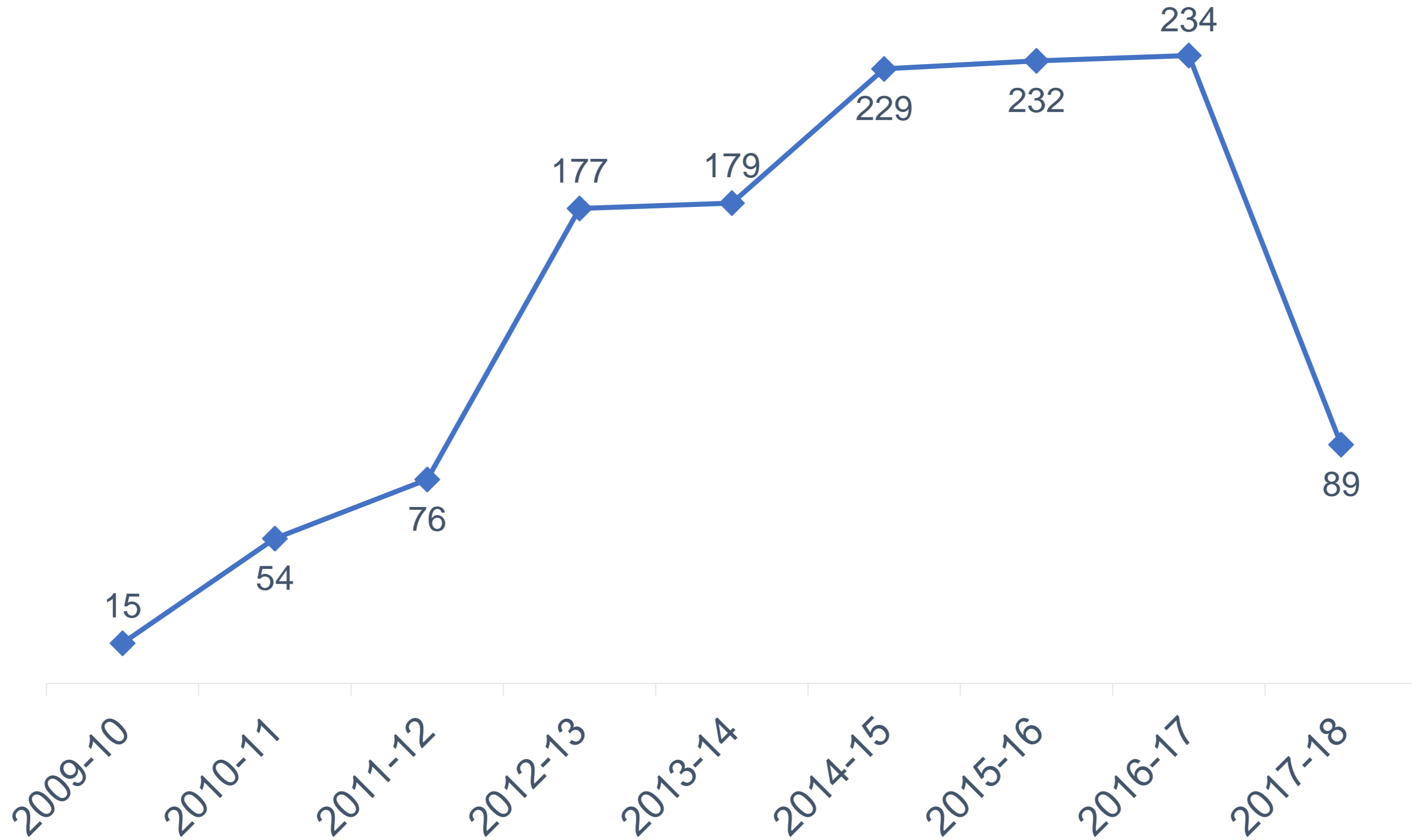

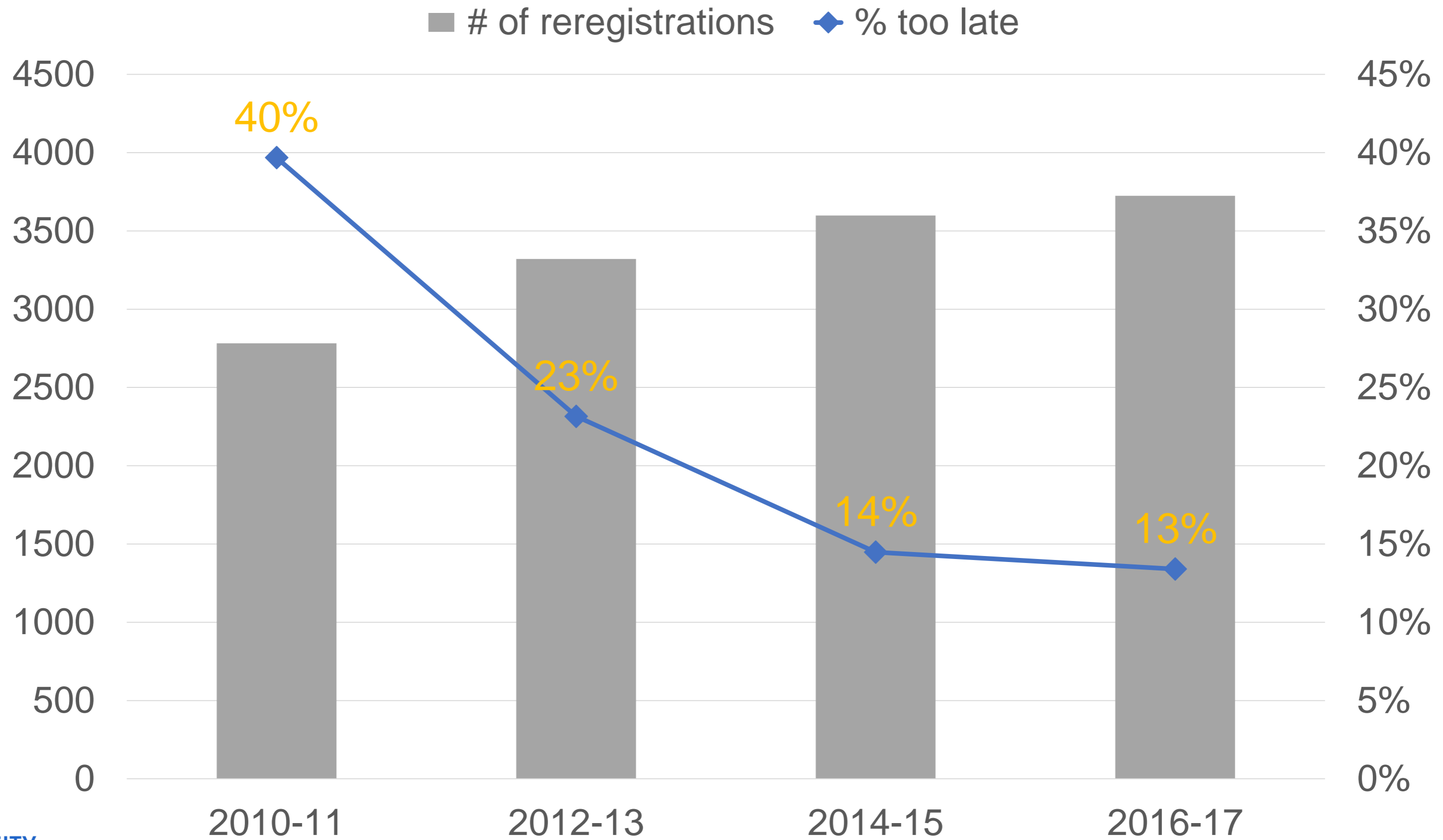
2008: 1ST SKILLS PROGRAMME (± 2000 SEATS)



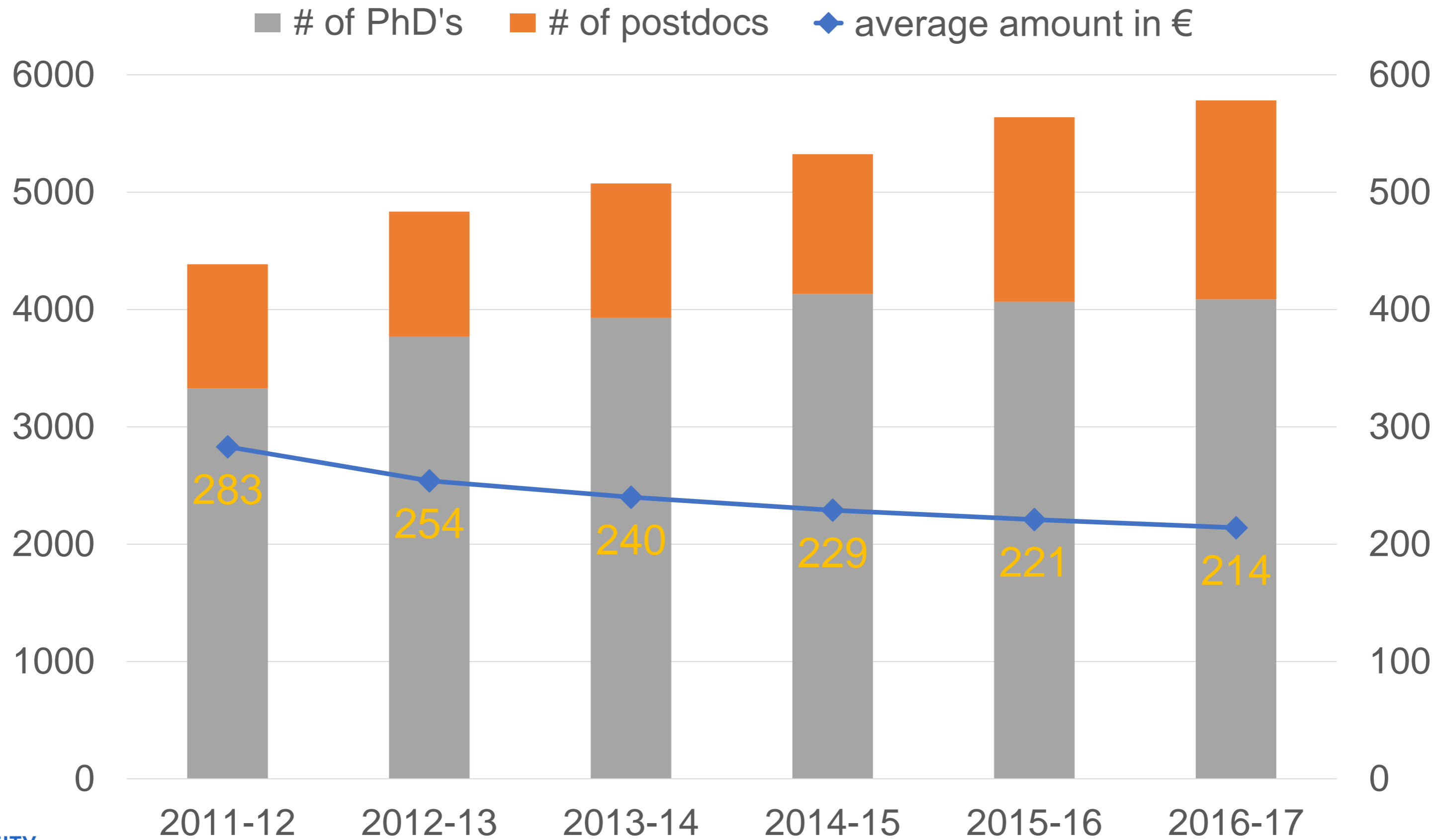
2009: 1ST OF 1281 DTP CERTIFICATES

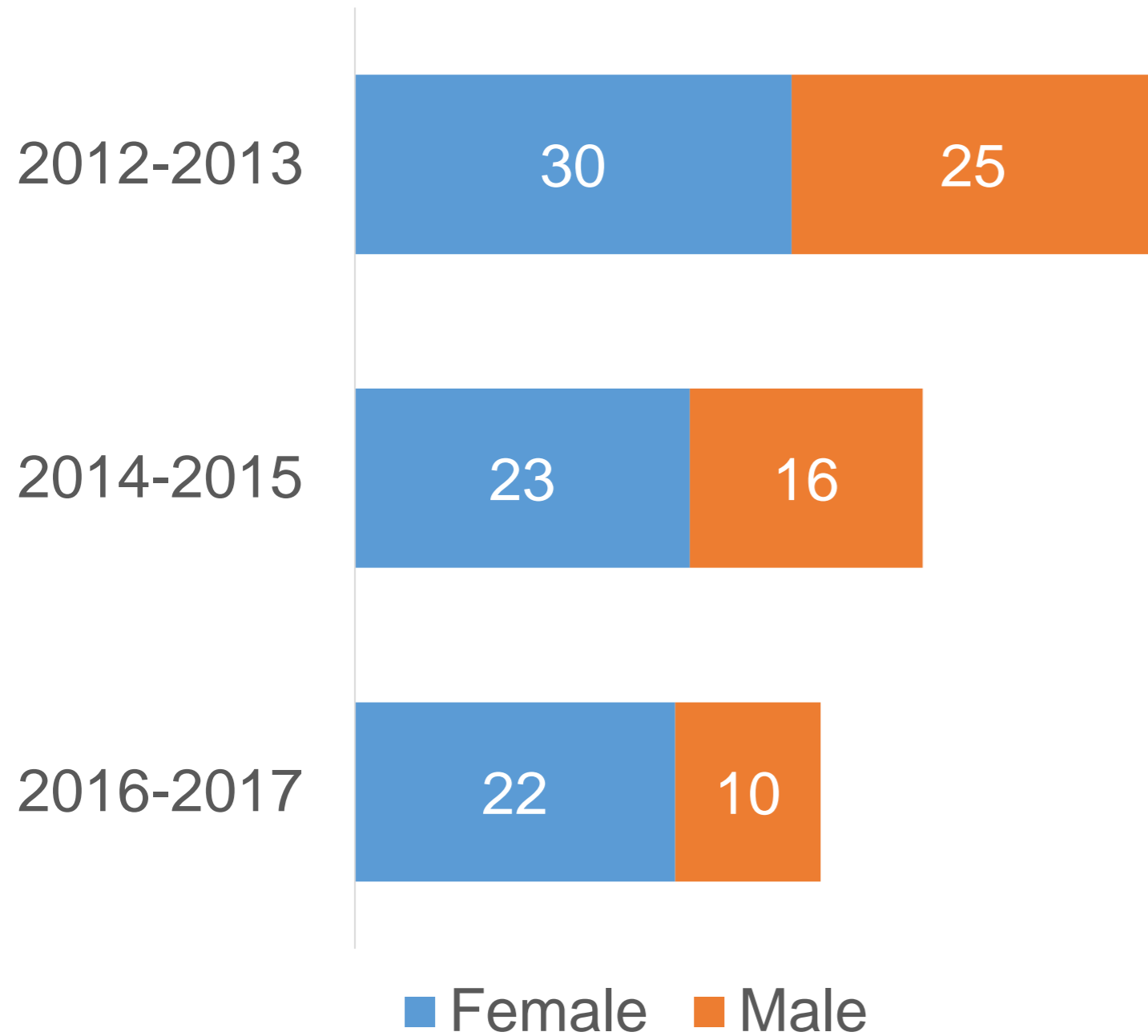

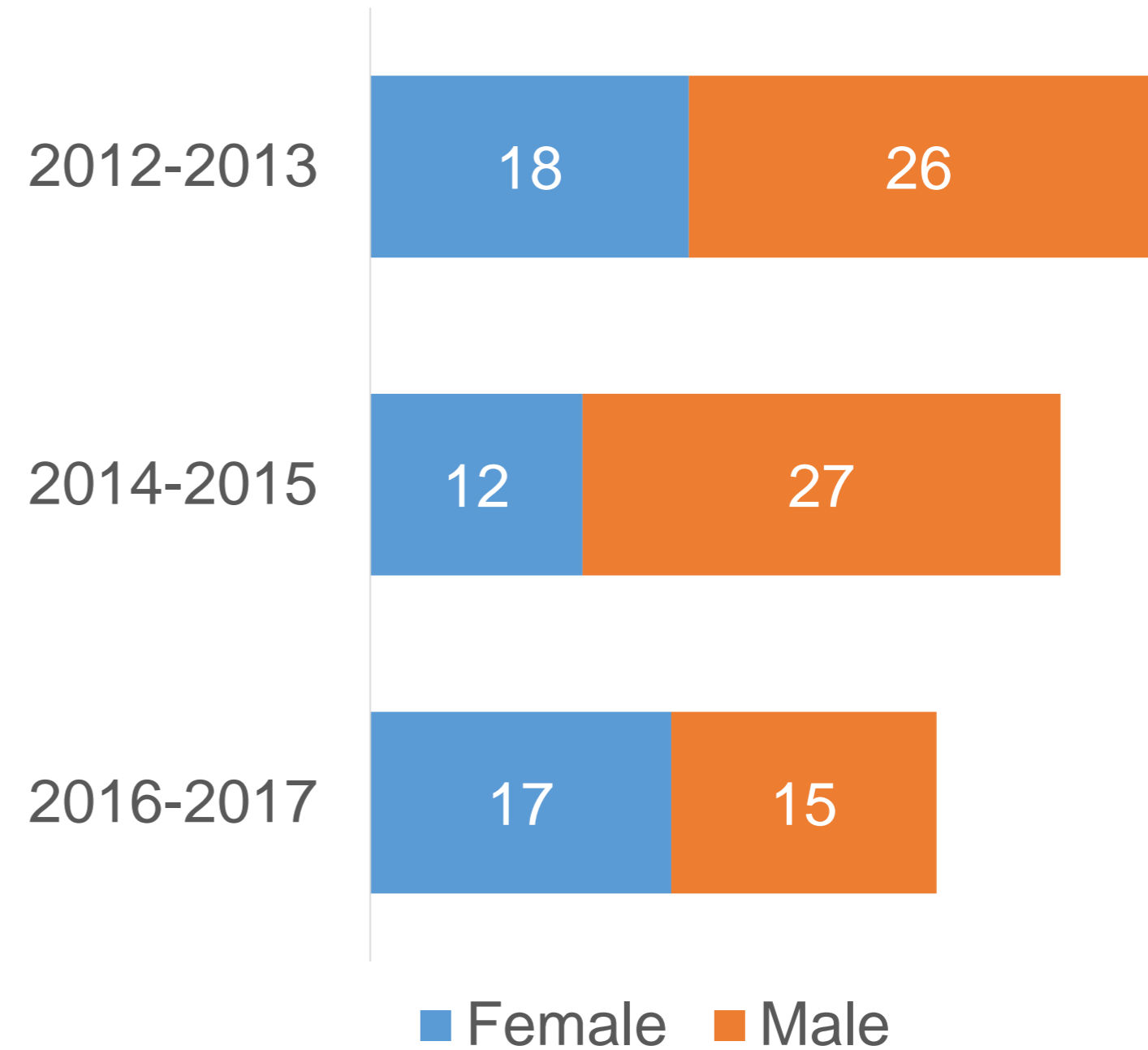

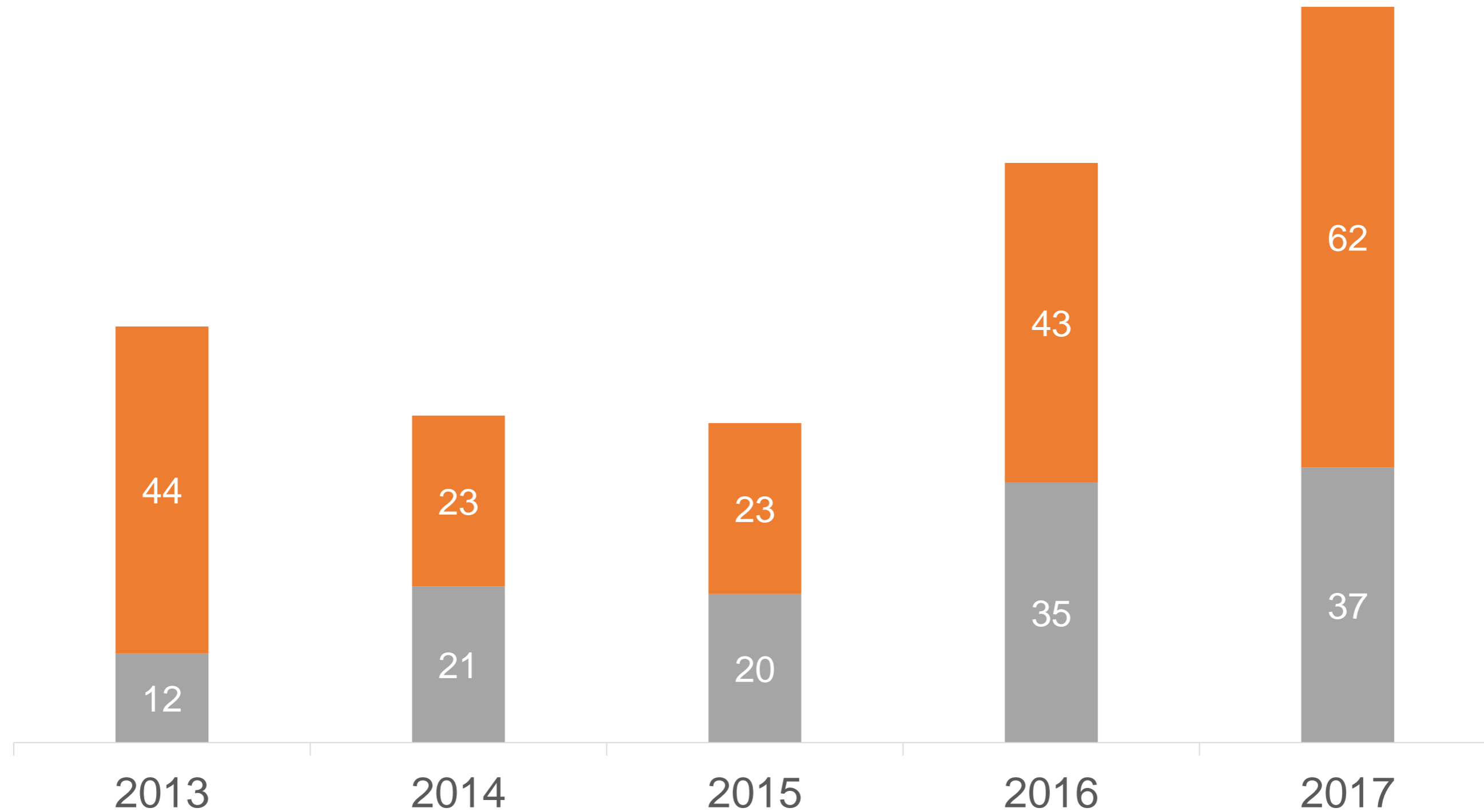

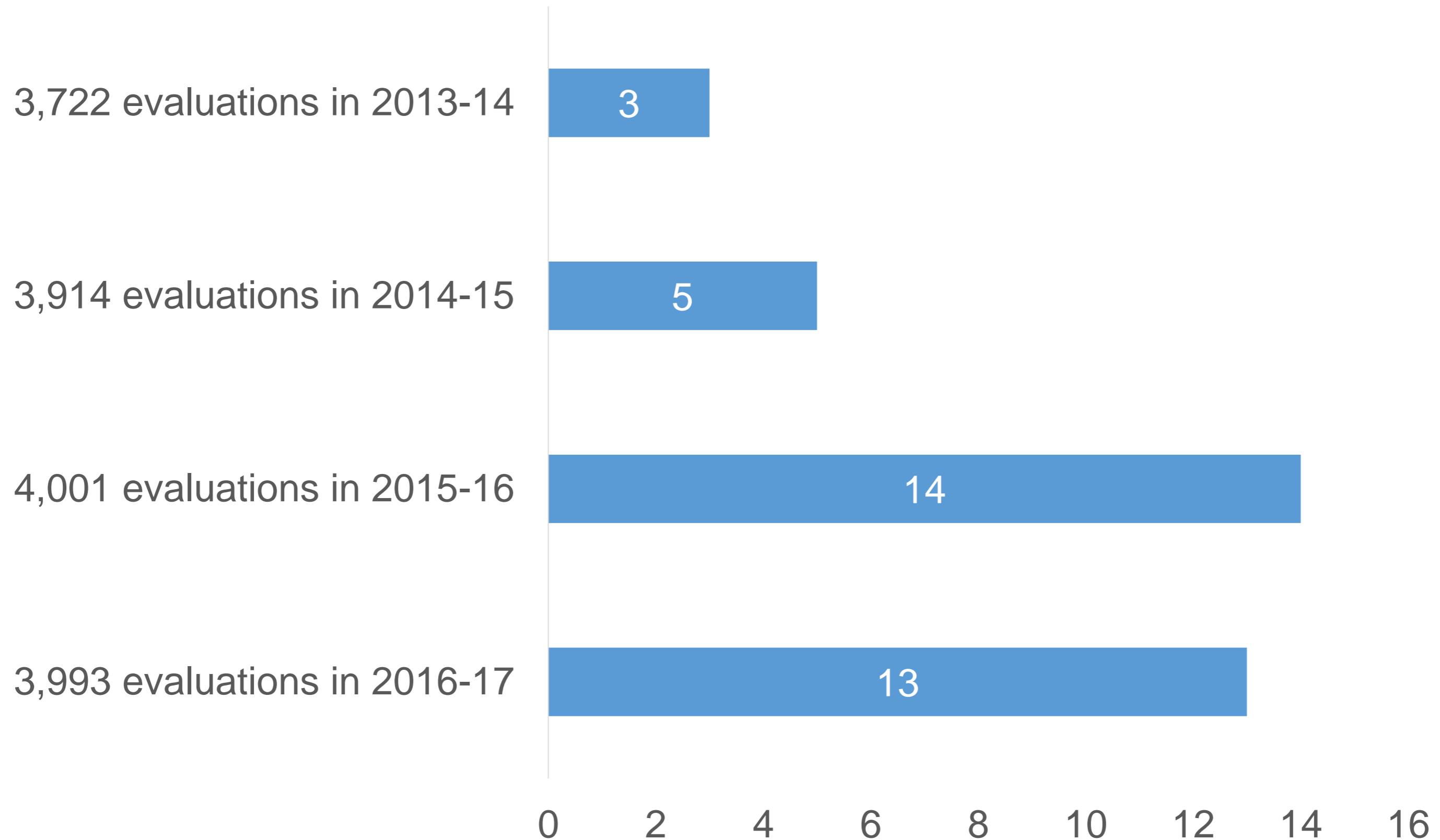

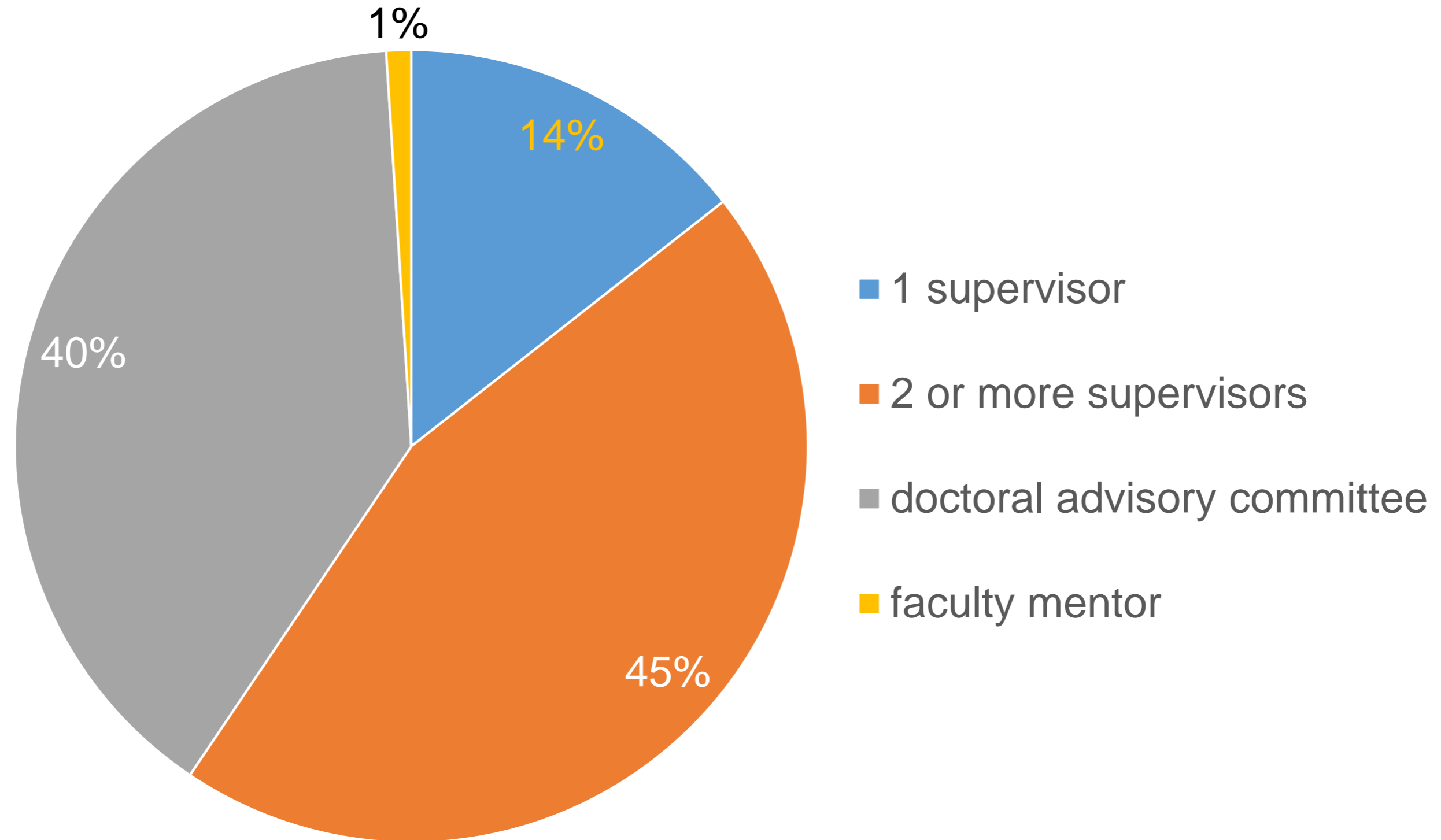

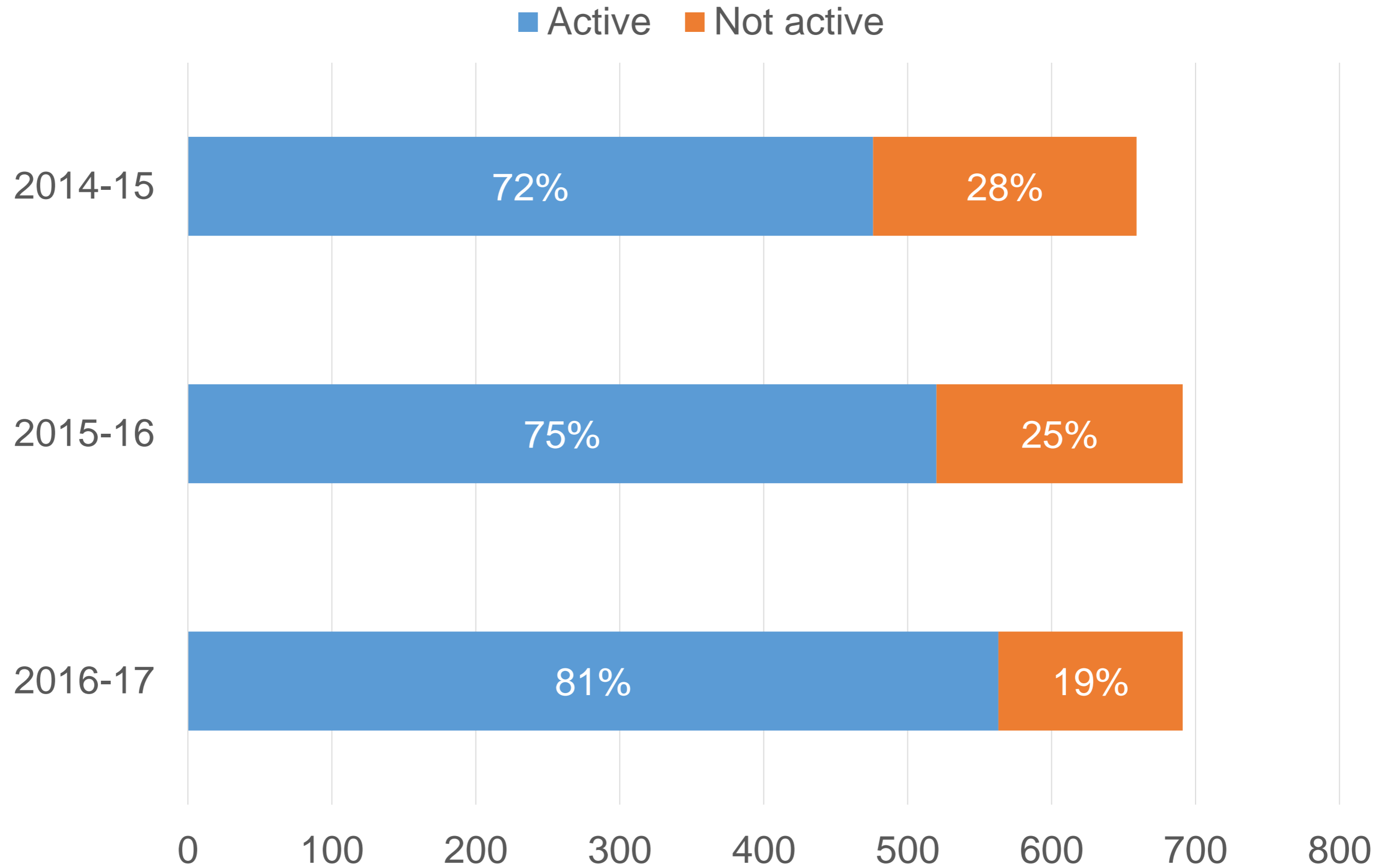

- #4 2010: from 40% to 13% late registrations
- #5 2011: OJO €283 to €214 per researcher
- #6 2012: 72 non-academic mentors in MenTa
- #7 2013: up to 99 booths for PhD's at #JMFYR
- #8 2014: 35 no-go's out of 15,630 evaluations
- #9 2015: single mentor down to 14% in 17-18
- #10 2016: 81% of graduates active in DTP
