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Setting the Stage

- Increasing attention given to Learning & Teaching
 - > EUA TRENDS: identifies universities developing L & T strategies
 - > EFFECT, a project to enhanced collaboration in L & T
 - > The EU Modernization and Renewed Agenda
 - Governmental pressure on HE, often connected to funding cuts



Setting the Stage

- The Forum, an EUA initiative to foster
 - Exchange of good practices and new L & T initiatives
 - > Through pan-European university collaboration
 - A European dialogue setting the priorities of HE for Europe,
 20 years after the Bologna Accords



Profound Changes to Society

Globalization

- > Seen as a threat, jeopardizing our cohesion, more than an opportunity
- Loss of confidence in science and technology

The Digital Revolution

- Transformation of all activities and processes
- > Overwhelming volume of information directly on the Internet

The Post-Factual World

> Difficulty of having an informed public discussion



New Demands on Universities

Manage the massive increase of students in HE

- From 1999 to 2005, enrollment in HE worldwide increased from 14 to 32% of the student-age population
- > Much greater diversity of student populations
- > Much greater range of education opportunities needed

• Prepare students

- > To be agile and efficient in the knowledge society
- > Where the nature of jobs is rapidly evolving
- > And requires life-long learning



The European Learning & Teaching Forum

- A bottom-up process with 4 thematic peer groups
 - 1. Building a link between research and teaching missions
 - 2. Empowering students in preparation for their future professional life and civic engagement
 - 3. Addressing larger and more diverse student bodies, ensuring student success
 - 4. Fostering engagement in the development of learning and teaching in institutions



Main Challenges

For students:

- Learn how to learn and expect continued learning and adapting throughout their careers
- Develop critical thinking to intelligently sort through the avalanche of digital information
- Acquire conceptual skills and processes, rigorous foundations in disciplines
- Increase international experiences to become acclimated to the larger world around them



Main Challenges

- For higher education institutions:
 - ➢ Build a conductive culture on L & T
 - Learn how to teach students how to learn to learn
 - Incorporate the broad range of tools and approaches to education
 - > Enable more customized ways of learning
 - > Offer orientation services from day-one until graduation
 - Favor and acknowledge the investment of staff in L & T



Main Challenges

- For national governments:
 - > Ease the regulation to reinforce academic and staffing autonomy
 - Promote university-driven initiatives
 - > Allow experimentation
- For national governments and the EU:
 - Be aware of the contribution of L & T to facing European challenges and acknowledge university achievements
 - Develop policies, measures and instruments to support L & T
 - Provide the appropriate funding to enable and sustain experimentation



A Continuous Dialogue to Follow Up

- A new set of thematic groups to identify best practices in 2018
- Next L&T Forum planned in 2019
- Development of informed recommendations to policy makers and stakeholders to set a new stage for the Bologna Process
