# **Getting around**

#### How to get from the airport to the city

There is a range of options available for your travel between the airport "Wien-Schwechat" and the city of Vienna:

- The cheapest is the Express train S7 that runs every 30 minutes and connects you to a number of stations in the city like "Wien Mitte-Landstraße", "Wien Praterstern", and "Wien Floridsdorf". The travel time between the airport and "Wien Mitte-Landstraße" is 25 minutes. The price of a single ticket is € 2.40. You can buy your ticket at the vending machines at the airport.
- If you want to travel a bit more comfortably and faster, you can take the <u>CAT City Airport</u> <u>Train</u> that offers a non-stop connection between the airport and "Wien Mitte-Landstraße". Travel time is just 16 minutes. The price of a single ticket is € 11, the return ticket is € 19. You can buy your ticket <u>online</u> or at the vending machines at the airport.
- There are also bus connections serving different locations in the city from the airport. - If you prefer door-to-door service, you can hire a limousine or a taxi either in advance online or upon arrival at the airport. A number of companies offer fixed price service, for details you can counsult <a href="https://www.flughafentaxi-wien.at/en/">https://www.flughafentaxi-wien.at/en/</a>.

#### How to get to the venue

**Campus WU** is located between two **U2** underground stations: "Messe-Prater" and "Krieau". You can buy your tickets at vending machines at all underground stations as well as at the ticket

office at "Hauptbahnhof" and "Praterstern". Furthermore, you can buy your tickets <u>online</u> in advance.

From the airport (see also information above):

- If you travel by Express train S7: leave the train at "Wien Praterstern". From there take the underground U2 in the direction of "Seestadt/ Aspernstraße". Get off at the stop "Messe Prater" and follow the signs to WU (app. 500m).
- If you travel by CAT: when you arrive in "Wien Mitte", follow the signs to the underground and take the U4 in the direction of "Heiligenstadt". Get off at "Schottenring" and change to U2 in the direction of "Seestadt/ Aspernstraße". Get off at the stop "Messe Prater" and follow the signs to WU (app. 500m).
- If you take the **bus** to the main train station "Hauptbahnhof": see information below.
- If you take a **taxi**, please instruct the driver to go to WU using the following address: **Trabrennstraße 1**, 1020 Wien

#### From the main train station "Hauptbahnhof":

If you arrive at Vienna's main train station "Hauptbahnhof", follow the signs to the underground. Take the UI in the direction of "Leopoldau". Get off at "Praterstern" and change to U2 in the direction of "Seestadt/ Aspernstraße". Get off at the stop "Messe Prater" and follow the signs to WU (app. 500m).

#### From other points around Vienna:

 By car: WU's underground parking garage is located under the main boulevard running through the campus. The entrance to the garage is on Trabrennstrasse 1, 1020 Wien. The garage has 411 parking spaces; 180 spaces are for short-term parking, the rest is reserved for long-term pass holders.

Public transportation: Vienna offers an excellent public transportation network. Wiener

Linien operates all subways and streetcars as well as most bus lines. On weekends, the subway network operates 24 hours a day. You can download a map of Vienna's underground, suburban rail (S-Bahn) and city airport service <u>here</u>. **Campus WU** is located between two **U2**underground stations: "Messe-Prater" and "Krieau".
