

2019 EUA-CDE THEMATIC WORKSHOP

Inter-institutional Collaboration in Doctoral Education

The call for contributions to the 2019 EUA-CDE Thematic Workshop on [“Inter-institutional Collaboration in Doctoral Education”](#) (only for EUA-CDE members, please consult [here](#) if your institution is a member) is now open. The event will be hosted by VU Amsterdam on 17 and 18 January 2019 in the Netherlands.

Contributions should be related to inter-institutional collaboration in doctoral education. Themes can include, but are not limited to:

- Starting inter-institutional collaboration
- Collaboration on the faculty level
- Collaboration with non-university partners
- International capacity building through inter-institutional collaboration
- Supporting inter-institutional mobility of doctoral candidates
- Sharing research infrastructure
- Research integrity challenges for inter-institutional collaboration

Contributors can **choose between two different settings** for their presentation:

- **Parallel working groups:** the first setting is a parallel working group presentation of max 10 minutes followed by a Q&A session with the audience. Each working group will start with one or two presentations.
- **Flash presentation:** the second setting are short interventions of max 5 minutes during the second plenary session on the first day of the event. Contributors can present examples of collaboration in doctoral education or concrete proposals or ideas for future collaboration. It can be about the experience of organising an inter-institutional collaboration, a specific challenge encountered or experiencing collaboration as a doctoral candidate.

To submit a contribution, please complete the [online proposal form](#). The deadline to apply is **4 November 2018**. We will notify you about the outcome of your submission soon after the deadline.

To help you prepare your contribution, please note that the online proposal form will ask you to provide the following information:

- Details of one presenter
- Details of an additional contact person and up to three co-authors (optional)
- Choose if this is a contribution to the parallel working groups or a flash presentation
- Choose to which above-mentioned theme the contribution relates most
- Contribution title
- Contribution summary (max 50 words)
- Contribution outline (max 800 words)

Participants presenting a contribution in a parallel working group will benefit from one reduced registration fee per presentation but are responsible for their own travel and accommodation expenses. There is no reduced registration fee for participants doing a flash presentation. After submitting a contribution, please do not register for the Workshop until the results have been announced. Participants entitled to a reduced registration fee will be asked to register through a separate registration process.
