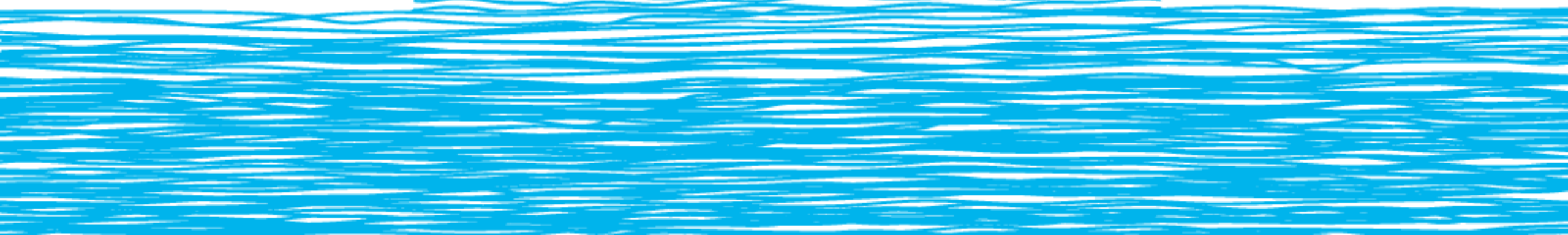

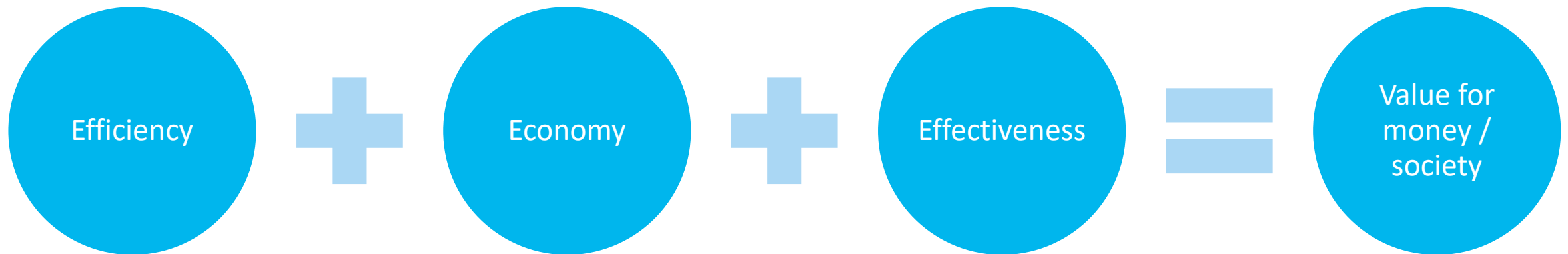

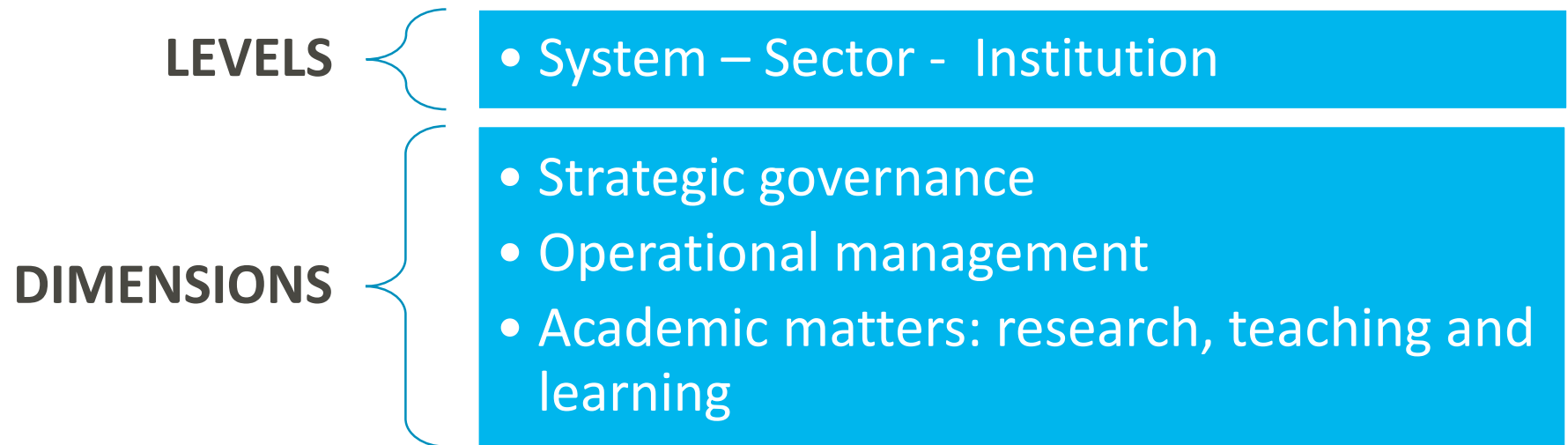
What is efficiency?

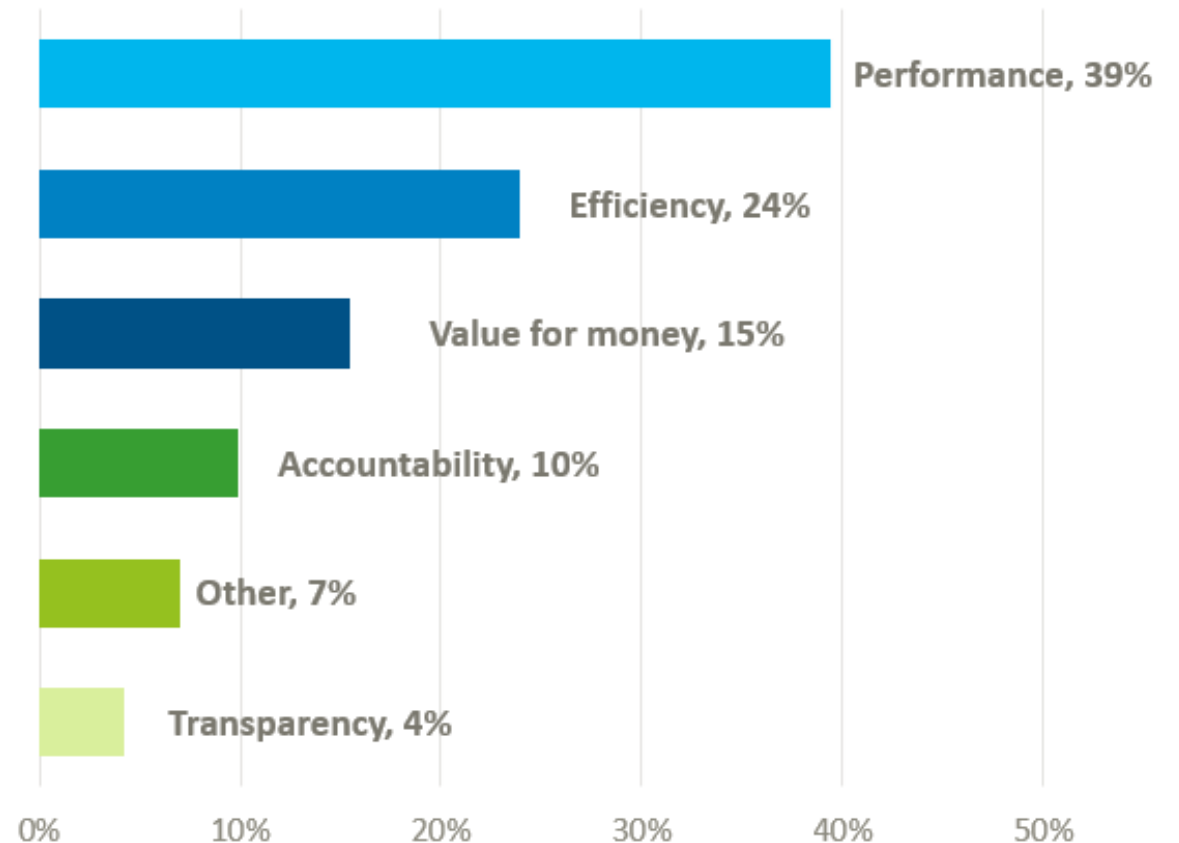

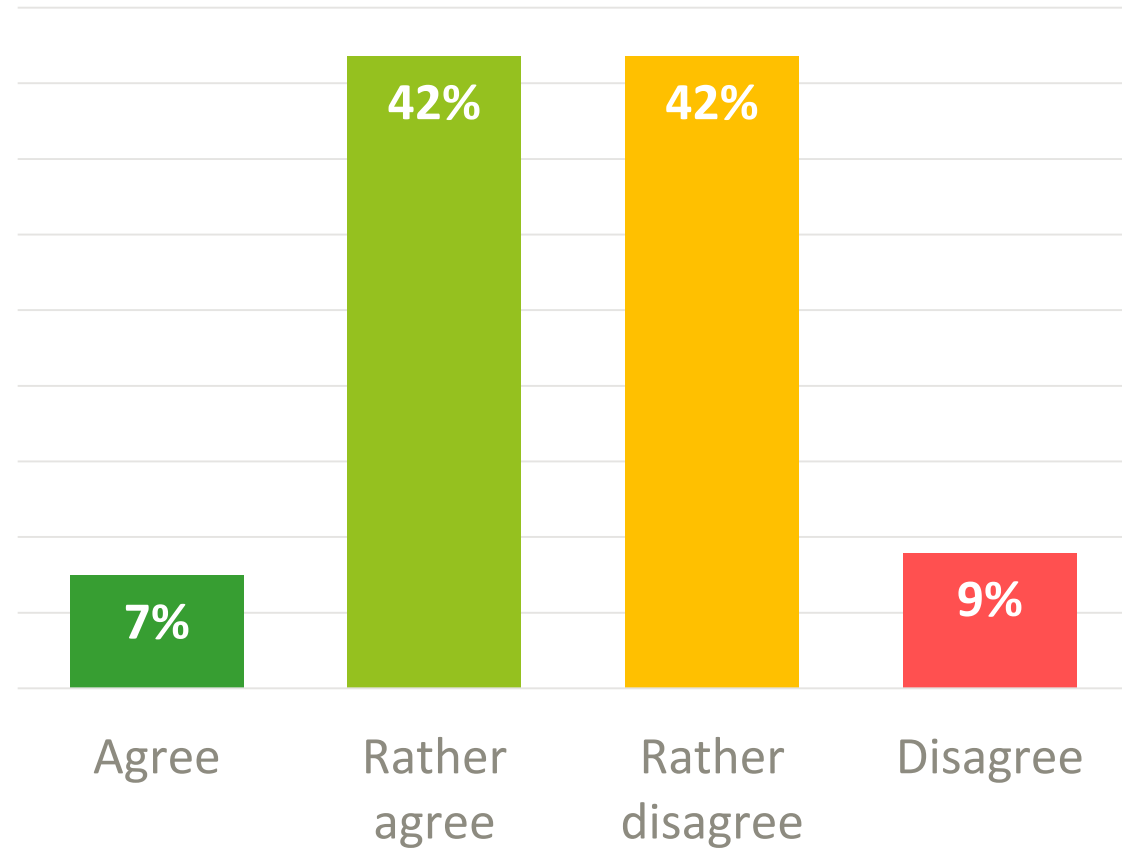
