ARCU-SUR System's features

- The Accreditation Process is directly linked to the economic bloc;
- National Accreditation Agencies are indicated by the countries;
- The System is coordinated by the Network of National Accreditation Agencies (RANA);
- Voluntary participation of universities;
- Limited number of degrees and just for undergraduate courses;
- Participation of foreign peers from the System's countries;
- The System is in development.


