ACCESS FROM AIRPORT, TRAIN STATION, OTHER PUBLIC TRANSPORT TO THE VENUE

BY PLANE

Paris has two [airports](#), **Paris-Charles de Gaulle (CDG)** and **Paris-Orly**.

How to get from Paris-CDG to the city centre:

- **Airport shuttle**
[Le Bus Direct](#) departs daily from all terminals between 5:45 to 23:00 (depending on Line) every 30 minutes. Tickets to the city centre are 18 EUR one way and 31 EUR return and can be purchased directly from the driver (1 EUR surcharge), at an automatic ticket machine or online.
- **Taxi**
[Taxis](#) can be taken from all three terminals at Paris-CDG.

- **Public transport**

It is also possible to travel into the city by [public transport](#) (RER rail or bus).

How to get from Paris-Orly to the city centre:

- **Airport shuttle**

[Le Bus Direct](#) departs daily from all terminals between 6:00 to 23:40 every 20 minutes.

Tickets to the city centre are 12 EUR one way and 20 EUR return and can be purchased directly from the driver (1 EUR surcharge), at an automatic ticket machine or online.

- **Taxi**

[Taxis](#) can be taken from all terminals at Paris-Orly.

- **Public transport**

It is also possible to travel into the city by [public transport](#) (RER rail or bus).

GETTING AROUND IN PARIS

Paris is very well connected by metro, bus and the RER suburban trains.

- **METRO**

A quick and easy way to travel around the city, as well as the best value. A single metro ticket costs 1.90 EUR, and can be used for one journey, including all connections. White-coloured tickets can be purchased singly or in a book of 10 ("carnet") for 14.50 EUR, at the ticket offices or machines in metro stations. The metro operates every day from around 06:00 to 00:30. The times of the first and last trains vary depending on the point along the line that you are departing from. Trains are less frequent on Sundays and public holidays.

- **RER**

RER is a rail network covering most of the Ile-de-France region. It consists of 5 lines referred to by the letters A, B, C, D and E. Within Paris, the RER operates in more or less the same way as the metro, except that you need to put your ticket through the automatic barriers a second time on the way out. If your RER station has a connection with the metro, you can use the same ticket for the whole journey.

- Using the RER is faster than the metro because stops are less frequent. It operates every day, including public holidays, from around 06:00 to 00:30. The regularity of the trains is similar to the metro, although you may have to wait longer for trains to certain suburban destinations. In the RER, as long as you remain within the city limits, tickets and prices are identical to the metro (RER stations also have their own ticket offices and machines).

- **BUS**
The bus network matches and complements that of the metro. Buses operate from Monday to Saturday from 07:00 to 20:30. Some bus lines also operate in the evening from 20:30 until 00:30, in particular those that begin at train stations or serve major metro and RER links, as well as the 3 circular PC routes.
