Comparable initiatives

- > 2 renown Latin Americans universities (100 courses on Coursera)
- > 2 projects in Europe (but different)
- The Bavarian Virtual University (each partner offers online courses on the common LMS)
- Erasmus+ Virtual Exchange offering intercultural learning experiences
- A common platform of 8 Finnish universities






MOOCs / SPOCs for credits – The main Framework

- 3-12 credits to get from the partner university
- English or native language: choice of the university offering the courses
- Courses must be available online
- Proposed courses must be linked to credits at home
- Host will give the credits
- Host University is responsible for the exam subject
- Home university is responsible for the proctoring
- Like in Erasmus agreement:
 - The host gives the grades, the home institution translates it to its own grading
- Home institution / faculty needs to acknowledge the courses
 - Depending on the curriculum
 - Depending on the student



Goals & benefits of a virtual exchange

For the students:

- ✓ Larger choice of elective courses from prestigious universities

Proctored on campus, exams on a secured platform

Only courses that are offered for credits at home university as well

No fees for the duration of the pilot

Credits?

Home university grants the credits / Included on diploma supplement

Permission?

Student requests permission via the same route as for any external course or semester abroad

European Virtual Exchange

- » Moocs available at Sorbonne University
- » Moocs of our partners

Since September 2017, 7 European universities, including Sorbonne University, have launched a pilot project. They mutually offer SPOCS (Small Private Online Courses) or MOOC (Massive Open Online Courses) to students from partner universities as optional courses, which are offered to their own students as part of their curriculum and linked to credits. Students will therefore obtain ECTS (<u>http://www.agence-erasmus.fr/page/ects</u>) for courses placed online at another university.

Depuis Septembre 2017, 7 universités européennes, dont Sorbonne Université, ont lancé un projet pilote. Elles proposentmutuellement des SPOCS ((Small Private online Courses) ou MOOC (Massive Open Online Courses) aux étudiants des universités partenaires en tant que cours optionnels, qui sont proposées à leurs propres étudiants comme des cours faisant parti de leurs cursus et reliés à des crédits. Les étudiants obtiendront donc des ECTS (<u>http://www.agence-erasmus.fr/page/ects</u>) pour des cours mis en ligne dans une autre université.

- ➢ 40 onlines course
- S1: 23 selected courses, 3 examens passed (3 taken)
- S2: 182, selected cours, 38 examens passed (32 taken)
- Sorbonne: 1 outgoing (3 courses), 2 passed (3 taken)
 - 2 ingoing (0 taken)
- •2018-2019
- S1: 36 outgoing @ SU, 2 ingoing





Challenges

- Heavy administration and coordination work
- > Autonomous work for students with risk of drop out
- Different systems and customs (credits, teaching time periods...)
- Convince study directors to let students take electives in their curriculum
- > Matching in level / thematic and semester with the course offer





Students' Virtual Exchange program The news

- Sharing our new courses within the EVE consortium and proposing our partners' courses at SU
- Building the LERU consortium under the "LERU brand" (leading with Leiden university)
 - Several universities declared their interest to participate
 - Preparing of the agreements for this consortium



Conclusion

- > First possibility of international exchange /mobility for distance students
- Universities could offer online courses for credits as part of the residential student curriculum
- Large number of exchange for a first year
- Creating another consortium under the LERU Brand
- Interest in general to develop European initiatives and collaboration to extend virtual mobility
