



# Raise awareness!




- Conduct research

## Challenges

- Strong *support-acknowledgment-drive* by the university leadership
- Early adapters among Deans, PhD coordinators, Graduate School/Doctoral School Heads
- Skepticism among traditional research directors

## Key messages

- Societal engagement is also a state of mind teamwork with society, reciprocity with society.
- 2. Raising awareness and creating socially engaged mindsets by integrating varied activities that challenge the traditional academic path throughout the PhD trajectory-structuring.
- 3. Changing traditional academic minds needs support from the university leadership (*initiators* or *supporters*).
