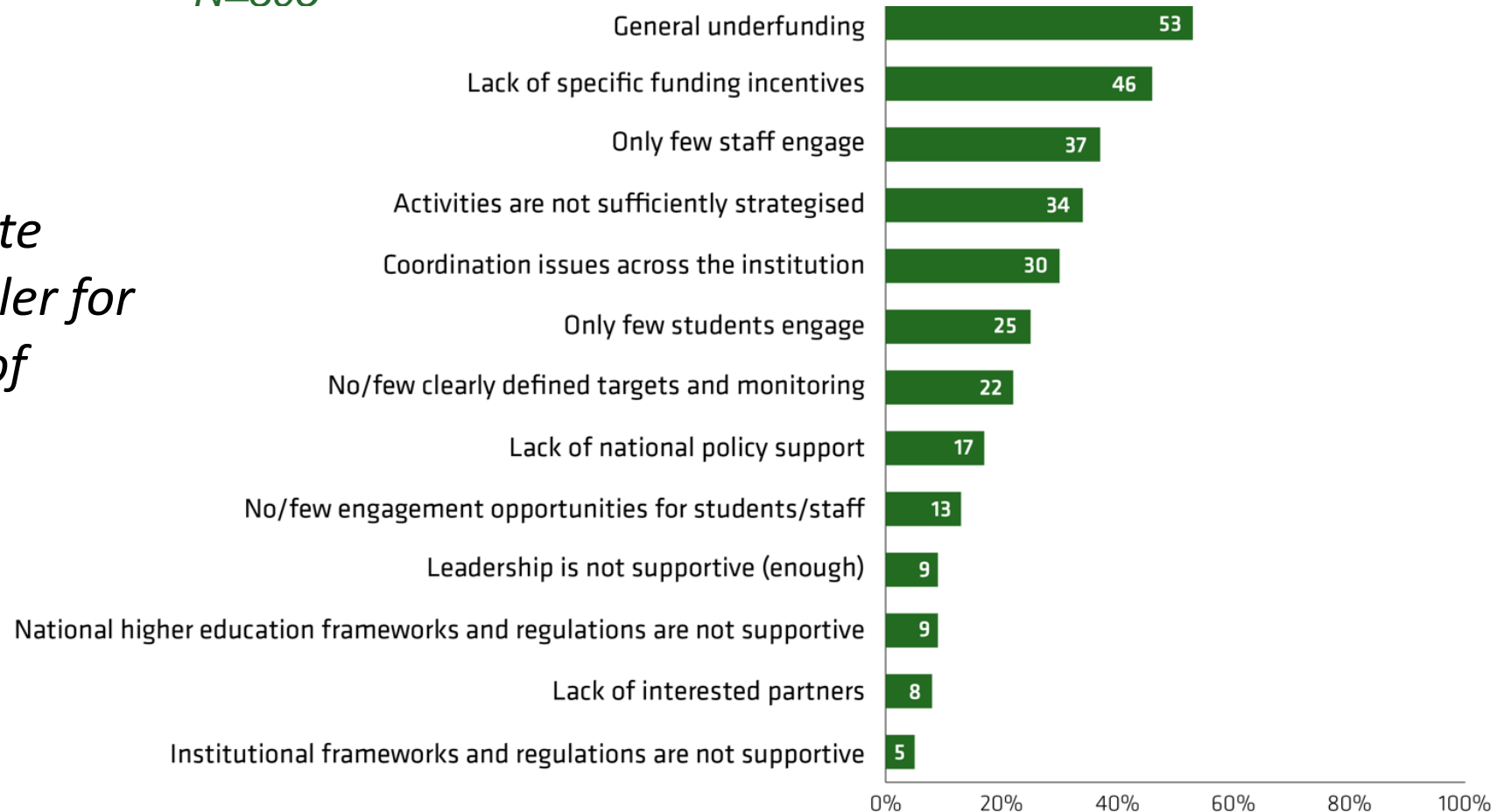


Funding

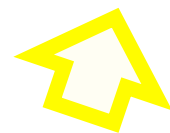
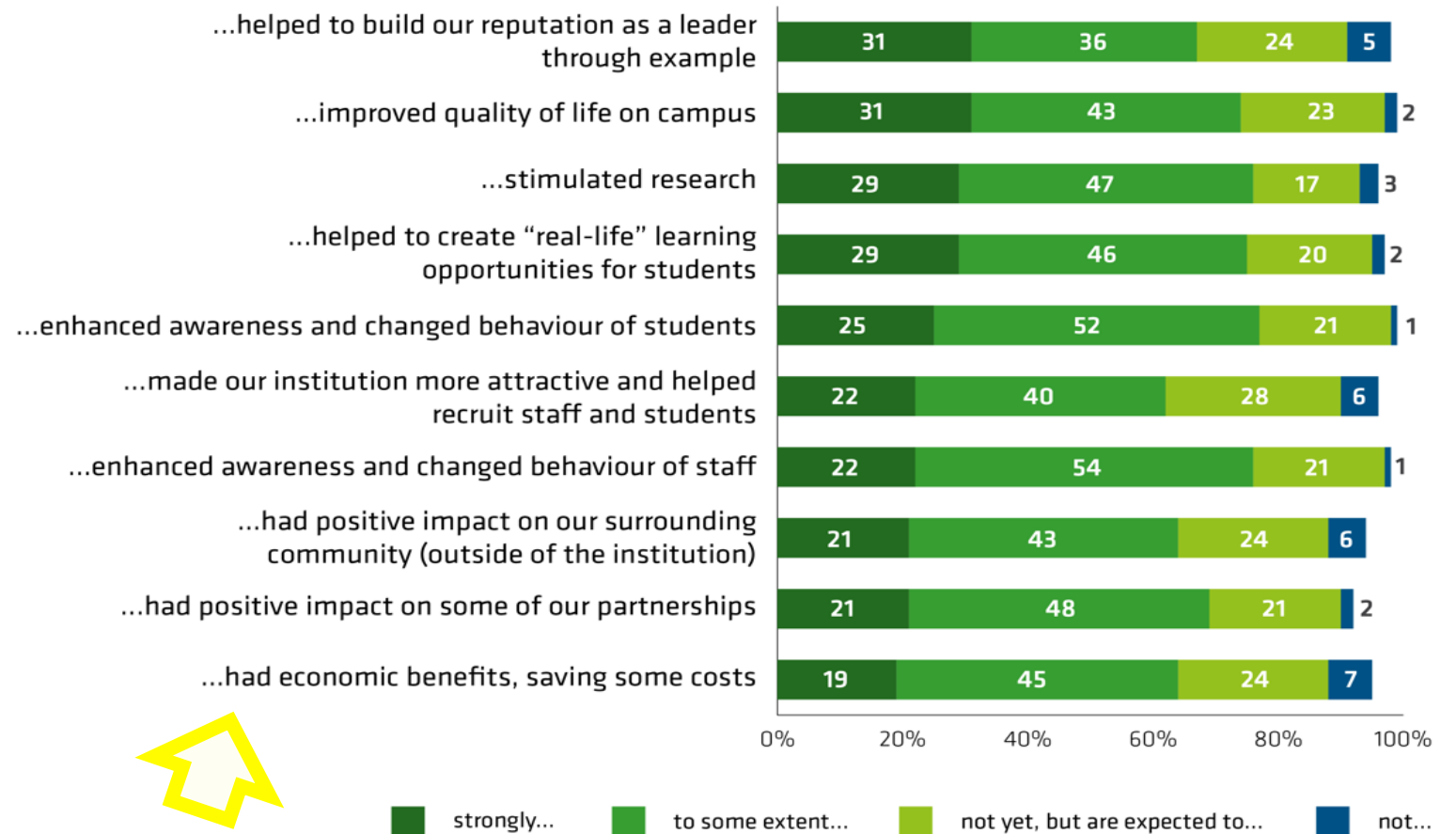


Impact of institutional greening activities

Key message: Measures such as asset sharing, shared services, etc. do not only have an impact on greater efficiency, but also in achieving greater sustainability

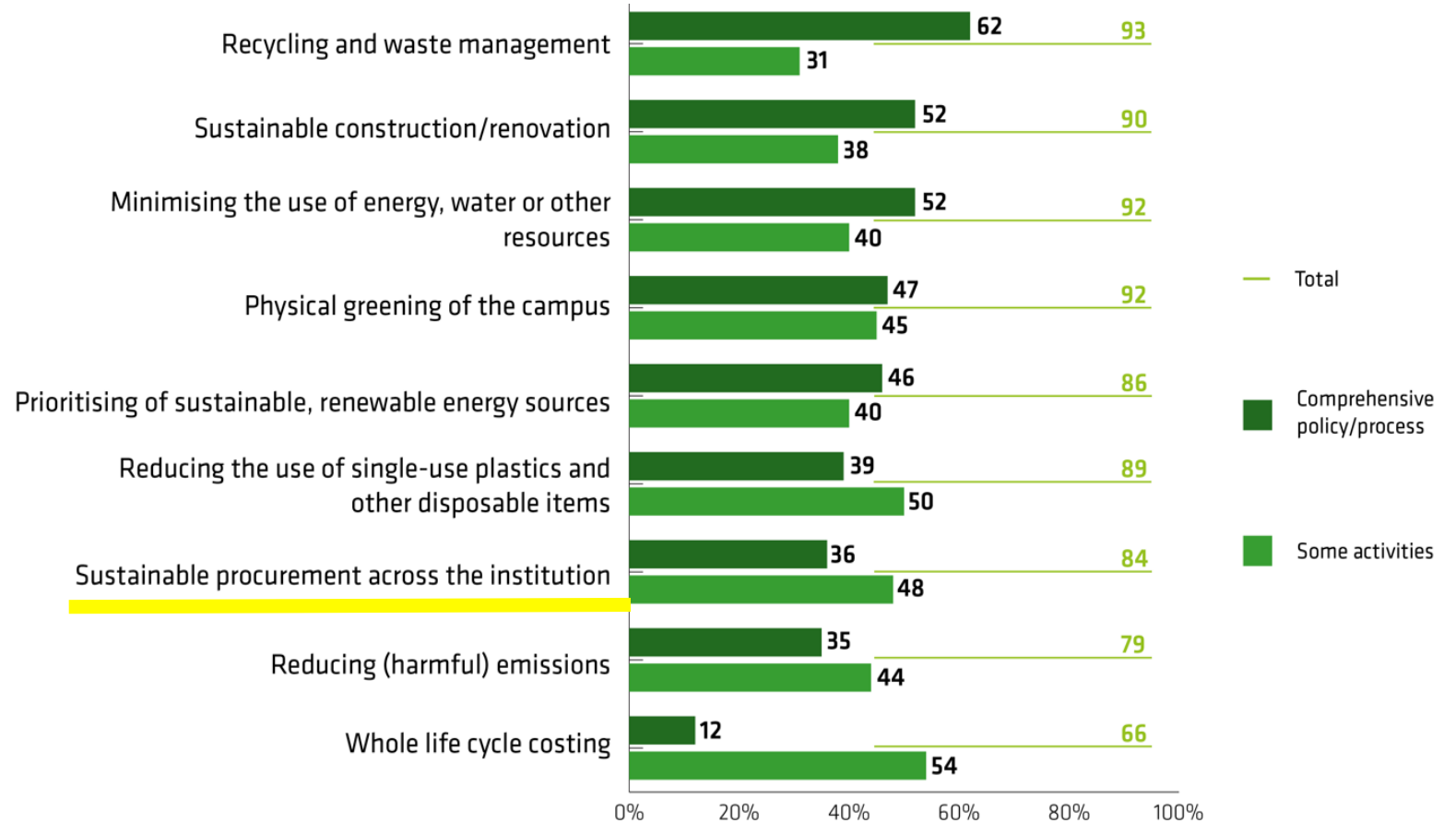

Ensuring a sustainable campus N=305



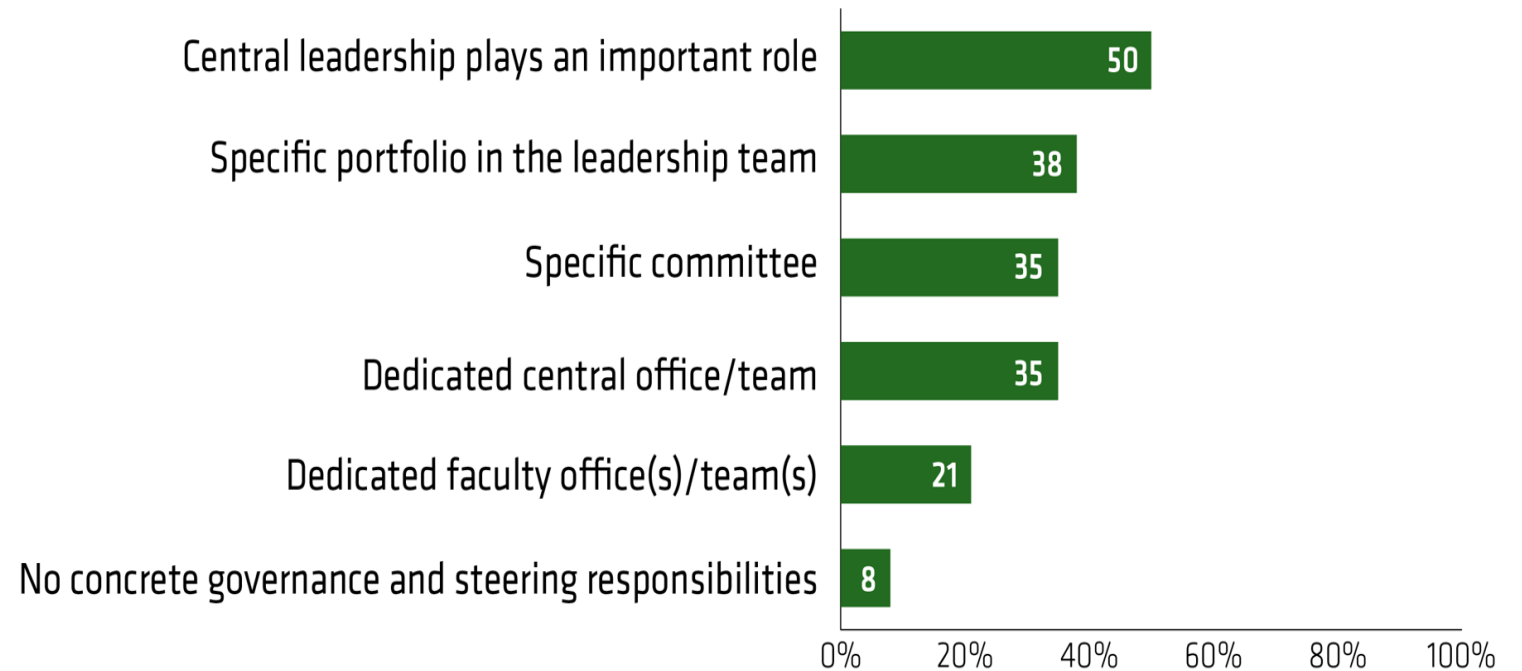


Leadership & Governance
