How to increase students' participation and commitment in mandatory QA-processes

Course Evaluation

- **mandatory participation for students**
 - although no consequences
- **Every course – every year**
 - last-but-one course unit
 - Results are sent to lecturer and study programme director
- **Discussion of results (lecturer and students)**
 - last course unit
- **Results of evaluation and discussion**
 - basis for student interviews
 - basis for curriculum development

Course evaluation – return rates

Course Evaluation

Project in 2021/2022:

Design of a new questionnaire

- Questions (old version):
 - Scale questions (1 – 5):
 - Organisation of courses (goals, content, teaching methods, infrastructure)
 - Course content (material, practical relevance)
 - Tutor (engagement, competence, interactivity)
 - Personal assessment (students' engagement)
 - Overall impression
 - Verbal feedback
- Questions (new version):
 - Scale questions (1 – 6):
 - Organisation of tuition (objectives, content, teaching methods, workload, timing)
 - Course content (structure, material, practical relevance, verbal feedback: further content or topics necessary?)
 - Tutor (engagement, competence, interactivity, connections to other subjects, verbal feedback: additional issues)
 - Knowledge and competence growth (increase of knowledge, verbal feedback: why yes/no, students' engagement)
 - Remarks and observations and additional comments regarding the rating
 - Overall impression

Course Evaluation

Project in 2021/2022

Project group

- 2 directors of study programmes
- 2 external lecturers
- 2 internal lecturers
- 2 students
- 2 QA

Preparation:

- Student feedback from course evaluation
- Student feedback from student interviews (once a year)

Course Evaluation

Pilote:

In 2 study programmes

- Bachelor Nursing
- Master Business Process Management and Engineering

Expectations:

- increase of return rate
- Better quality of verbal feedback
