Currency and banking

The currency in Poland is Zloty (PLN). Currency exchange facilities can easily be found in shopping centres and the city centre (e.g. Old Town). Some fuel stations and souvenir shops may accept EUR, but this way of paying is not recommended due to unfavourable exchange rates. Cashpoints are often accessible 24/7 and they can be found all over the city and near the Gdańsk Tech campus. Most shops and payment terminals (e.g. ticket machines) accept Visa and Mastercard credit cards, which are a preferred option for payment following the Covid-19 pandemic.

Voltage

Electricity in Poland is supplied at 230 volts.
