How to get to Aveiro:

From Porto Airport – 1.5 to 2 hours by public transport to Aveiro

Francisco Sá Carneiro Airport (Porto Airport) is located 80km north of the city of Aveiro.

The train is the best and cheapest way to get to Aveiro from Porto Airport, as it takes you close to the city center. If you arrive at Porto Airport you can take an underground train from the airport to the main train station Campanhã (Porto – Campanhã). From Campanhã station you can take the train to Aveiro Train Station.

Step 1: *Metro from Airport to Campanhã Station:*

The Metro (title Z4 Andante ticket) costs about €2.60 and takes about 40 min from Porto airport to Porto – Campanhã train station

Step 2: *Train from Campanhã Station to Aveiro*

When you are at Porto – Campanhã train station, you can take the train to Aveiro. You have several options:

- High-speed Intercidades and Alfa Pendular trains take about 50 min to reach Aveiro but are a bit more expensive (Intercidades costs about €13 and Alfa Pendular between €15-21).
- Local suburban trains offer a regular service throughout the day. The trip takes about 70 min and costs €3.55.

Alternatively, you can take a taxi from the airport to the main train station in Porto (Porto – Campanhã): A taxi costs about €25 and the journey from Porto airport to Porto – Campanhã train station takes about 25 min.

Aveiro train station is within walking distance (15 minutes) from Aveiro city centre. From Aveiro train station you can also take the Bus or Taxi to move around the city.

The Aveiro Bus Line 11 stops at the Venue (Universidade – Reitoria). The stop you should get off at is **Universidade – Reitoria**, it is not listed in the schedule but it is a stop. (it is the next stop after Universidade – Antiga Reitoria). The ride takes approximately 10 min and the ticket costs €2.05 (you can buy the ticket on the bus).

Alternatively, you can also rent a car at Porto airport and drive south to Aveiro. This is a 75km trip, mostly on the highway, and should take about 1 h.

From Lisbon Airport - 3 hours by public transport to Aveiro

Portela / Humberto Delgado Airport (Lisbon Airport) is located about 250 km south of the city of Aveiro. As this is a long trip, the best is to take a train from Lisbon to Aveiro using an Intercidades or an Alfa Pendular train.

Step 1: *From Lisbon Airport to Lisboa Oriente Station:*

Take the Metro, using the red line to Oriente train station. The ticket costs €1.50 <https://www.metrolisboa.pt/>

Take a taxi, which costs about €10 and takes around 15 min.

Take the bus (705 and 744) to the bus station Oriente, which costs about €1.80. You can buy your ticket on the bus.

Step 2: *Train from Oriente Station to Aveiro*

When you get to Lisbon – Oriente train station, you can take the high-speed Intercidades or Alfa Pendular train to Aveiro. The Intercidades and Alfa Pendular trains take about 2 h and 2h30 min (respectively) to reach Aveiro. Intercidades costs between €21-31 and Alfa Pendular between €28-€40).

-Local suburban trains offer a regular service throughout the day. The trip takes about 70 min and costs €3.55.

Aveiro train station is within walking distance (15 minutes) from Aveiro city centre. From Aveiro train station you can also take the Bus or Taxi to move around the city.

Alternatively, you can also rent a car at Lisbon airport and drive north to Aveiro. This is a 255km trip, mostly on the highway, and should take about 2h45 min.
