Taxi services

Taxis are a popular and affordable choice in Armenia.

Ride-hailing apps like GG Taxi and Yandex Go operate widely in Yerevan, ensuring transparent fares and easy booking.

Official airport taxis are also available directly outside the arrivals hall.



Metro

The nearest metro station to the university is Yeritasardakan Station (around a 5-minute walk).

Tickets can be bought online on Yerevan Transport or from ticket machines (cash or card)



From the airport

By Bus: Travelers can take bus number 100 directly from Zvartnots International Airport to the city centre. The journey typically takes 28 minutes.

Weather & other information



- November in Yerevan is usually cool- average daytime temperatures around 8–15°C. Participants are advised to bring warm clothing.
- International dialling code of Armenia is +374 10
- Armenia uses European-style plugs (Type C and Type F), 230V supply voltage.
- The official currency of Armenia is the Armenian Dram (AMD). Credit and debit cards are widely accepted in hotels, restaurants, and shops.
