Legal framework for Doctoral Education in Georgia

- ☐ Governed by the Law on Higher Education (2005), with key reforms in 2024.
- □ 2024: New doctoral framework approved, aligned with Salzburg & ESG. Annex 6 introduces tailored doctoral program standards Covers: curriculum, supervision, resources, QA
- Accreditation mandatory: cluster accreditation under implementation.
- ☐ Focus: structured programs, quality supervision, interdisciplinary research.







	Grant offices set up in 10 universities








ENROLLMENT % BY YEAR AND FIELDS
