## Closest airports

- From Vienna Airport (**recommended**): reach Brno by bus (Regiojet or Flixbus) or by train (OBB)
- From Vaclav Havel Airport Prague: reach Brno by bus (Regiojet)
- From Bratislava Airport, you need to go first to Bratislava bus or train station and take a train (České dráhy) or bus (Regiojet) from there.

### Travel times from Vienna Airport to Brno:

1 h 30 min	2 h 05 min	1 h 30 min (150 km)

### Travel times from Prague Airport to Brno:

3 h 30 min	3 h 30 min	2 h 30 min (230 km)

### Travel times from Bratislava Airport to Brno:

## Public transport

### Getting around the city



- Public transport; 1-hour ticket €1
- Taxis; Liftago, Uber and Bolt are also available.
- Walking; Many locations in Brno are within walking distance

### How to get to the venue from the city center?

The campus is 25 minutes away by tram from the Brno main train station  
Take tram 12 and stop at Červinkova then walk toward the university building

## Currency & Language



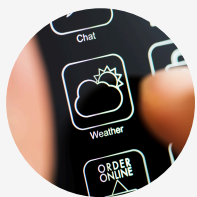
- Official currency of Czechia is Czech koruna (Kč)

## Weather



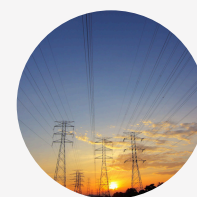
- October in Czechia is characterized by true autumn weather, featuring chilly, crisp days mixed with sunshine, with temperatures ranging from highs of 10–14°C
